**Re: Price Increase on March 3, 2025**

Consolidated Fabricators Corp., Building Products Division, will implement a **minimum price increase of 10-15%** on all steel products for shipments on or after **March 3, 2025**.

This adjustment is necessary due to rising costs resulting from the **administration's recent announcement of Section 232 tariffs, which impose a 25% duty on all imported steel**. While the United States primarily sources steel from Canada, Brazil, and Mexico, these tariffs—aimed at reducing reliance on foreign steel—are expected to **significantly increase the cost of both imported and domestic steel**. As domestic mills adjust to limited competition from lower-cost imports, we have already begun to see price increases, which we must now pass on to maintain stable operations.
