Re: Aluminum Trim Increase for April 1, 2025

To Our Valued Customers:

Due to the upcoming tariff on Aluminum imports set to begin on March 12, Flannery must announce a 25% increase on all aluminum trims effective April 1, 2025.

The current U.S. Administration has announced and signed a tariff of 25% on all aluminum products entering the United States. This tariff as it stands will be levied against both raw aluminum materials and finished goods.

While Flannery produces its aluminum trims in the U.S., our aluminum mills utilize aluminum billet that is produced overseas due to the lack of raw aluminum (or alumina and bauxite mining) production here.

We hope to see the U.S. President reconsider this tariff or at least lower it, but until further action is taken, we must announce our increase based on today's information. Our mills have already begun to see aluminum pricing increase in anticipation of the tariff and have passed those changes onto us.

If the tariff is rescinded or is lowered, we will remove or lower this increase immediately and inform you. If you have any questions about this increase or a previously bid project, feel free to contact your inside sales representative by phone or e-mail.
