Re: Additional Price Increase Effective May 5, 2025

Consolidated Fabricators Corp., Building Products Division, will implement an **additional price increase on all steel products for shipments on or after May 5**, **2025.** This increase is **in** addition to the previously announced April 1, 2025 price adjustment.

This decision is necessary due to **continued price increases from domestic mills** and **the ongoing impact of Section 232 tariffs**, which are driving up costs for both imported and domestic steel. As these tariffs remain in effect, we are seeing further market escalation, affecting steel availability, lead times, and overall pricing.

We understand the challenges these rapid fluctuations present and remain committed to keeping you informed while continuing to provide high-quality products and outstanding customer service. **Updated price pages** will be distributed as soon as they are available.

Please remember that we will honor job quotes committed to us in writing within 30 days of the quote date. All other quotes are subject to re-bid based on current market conditions.
